# Sixty Steps repairs

## Community update

Work to repair the section of the Sixty Steps wall below the belle-vue will start on **Monday 3 April 2017**.

- This will involve the **closure of Kelvinside Terrace West and Kelvinside Terrace South** for the duration of the repairs.
- Permission has been granted for the **removal of up to three trees** (Glasgow City Council has agreed to replace two of those with mature trees if their removal is necessary).
- The canopy of a further **tree will be pruned** to allow access for machinery.
- We have also been offered the services of professional tree surgeons to remove any dead wood and improve the crowns of the existing trees right along the top of the wall by carrying out some **crown thinning**. From an arboriculture point of view this is good for the health of the trees.
- The works contractor, Covanburn, plans to start work at 7am, and finish around 3pm. **There will be no Sunday working**.
- The pedestrian **footpath will remain open** throughout.
- **Vehicle access** to the area for residents' essential deliveries etc. can be arranged through the site office.
- When the works are completed, the **concrete blocks** on Queen Margaret Road will finally be removed.
